This statement is made pursuant to s.54 of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and sets out the steps that Foreland Shipping¹ and its subsidiary undertakings have taken and will continue to take to address the risk of modern slavery or human trafficking taking place within our business or supply chain. Modern slavery encompasses slavery, servitude, human trafficking and forced labour.

Foreland Shipping

Foreland Shipping is a UK based shipping company that operates a small fleet of 4 roll-on/roll-off vessels.

Foreland is committed to acting ethically and with integrity and transparency in all business dealings. Foreland aims to ensure there is no modern slavery or human trafficking in any part of its business and supply chain.

Accordingly, Foreland expects the same ethical conduct from all of its business relationships and suppliers. Foreland therefore expects each of its suppliers to have policies and procedures in place aimed at ensuring that slavery, human trafficking and child labour is not present within its supply chain.

Sustainability and values

Foreland will not tolerate the practice of modern slavery in any form and is committed to continue to work with all of its stakeholders and relevant regulators to combat this issue, wherever it may become aware of it.

The Board of Directors of Foreland Shipping Limited take responsibility for this policy and approved of this statement on 22nd May 2018.
